On the way back from Texas, we stopped to visit with several friends. It was my schedule to walk almost every morning for about an hour. I left the house before everyone was up and walked down a country road. It was a pleasant walk and I stopped to look into a huge gravel pit while on the walk.

Later that day company came over to visit. There was a little boy about 8 or 9 years old that was with them. He has no male adult relatives in his life and is raised by a single relative. I asked if he wanted to go for a walk to see a gravel pit. Of course he did, and we retraced part of my route I took earlier.

Very quickly I realized I had to slow down my walking pace. About 100 yards into the walk we stopped completely to look at some stones along the road. After he selected one, we were on our way. That was the first of many stops on our walk. I could not believe how many treasures I had walked by earlier that morning and never noticed.

By the time we returned home, he had collected a neat stone, a small tree limb that looked like a fan, a tooth and part of the jaw of a long ago dead possum, a pretty bird feather, and a piece of metal.

Once home he showed his treasures, and they were put in a plastic bag for him to take home. To me the walk was just exercise. Oh how I wish I could see everything through the innocent eyes of a child, non-judgmental and full of wonder, adventure and excitement.

Let us all take time to see and experience the wonders God has made. Take a little one for a walk of discovery for them and you.

The sad part of the story that broke my heart is when Rita and I were ready to leave, the little boy wrapped his body around my feet so I would not leave. Look for a little boy with no male figure and spend time with him.
